At the hearing, the court will consider whether an injunction should be entered in this case and if so, whether other things should be ordered, including whether temporary support should be paid, custody and visitation matters if there are minor children, and whether Respondent should attend any counseling programs.

This is the final hearing. All witnesses and evidence must be presented at this time. If the Petitioner does not appear, the case may be dismissed. If the Respondent does not appear, an injunction may be entered and additional relief may be granted. Children are not permitted to testify unless a motion is filed pursuant to Fla. Fam. L.R.P. 12.407, and an order allowing the testimony is granted prior to the hearing.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND STALKING HEARINGS:

Court proceedings concerning domestic violence or stalking are required by law to be recorded. This recording may be by electronic means. No written transcript of the Court's recording will be provided to the parties. Either party may arrange for a court reporter to prepare a written transcript of the hearing at that party's expense.

REPEAT VIOLENCE, DATING VIOLENCE, OR SEXUAL VIOLENCE HEARINGS:

The law does not require court proceedings concerning repeat, dating, or sexual violence to be recorded; however, either party may arrange for a court reporter to record the hearing and prepare a written transcript of the hearing at that party's expense. Arrangements for a court reporter must be made in advance.

A RECORD, WHICH INCLUDES A TRANSCRIPT, MAY BE REQUIRED TO SUPPORT AN APPEAL. THE PARTY SEEKING THE APPEAL IS RESPONSIBLE FOR HAVING THE TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY A COURT REPORTER.

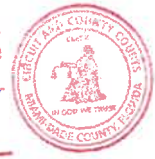


The respondent is employed and the petitioner's distant relative. The parties have known each other since birth. The petitioner is employed and alleges the following incidents have occurred as described below:

On September 2, 2023, the petitioner was at a funeral for a relative when the respondent parked behind the petitioner's truck, blocking the petitioner's parking space to take a picture of her license plate. In the moment, the petitioner believed the respondent was going to shoot her because the respondent's mother and the petitioner are in heavy litigation that the respondent is not involved in; yet the respondent is tampering and inflicting fear in the witness. The petitioner jumped out of the car, and took a picture of her license plate. The parties both drove away and at the light, the respondent lowered her window and said, "Do you know where I work, I know all there is to know about you, I don't need to take pictures of your tag." The petitioner made a U-turn almost causing a crash, went to Pembroke Pines police, and filed a report. Case #22-2309-007339 was issued.

September 1, 2023 at 1:07 am the petitioner was at her lawyers office for a deposition she petitioned when her attorney was aware that the Chief of Police of NMBPD (respondent) was present. The respondent was not summoned and her purpose was to impulsively stalk and intimidate the petitioner. The respondent has weaponized her role by nefariously influencing the NMBPD to commit illegal acts outside of official duty. The petitioner believes the respondent in an imminent threat to her. In the past, the respondent threatened her by stating she is trained to kill when the parties argued.
