REPORTED CONDUCT

Repeated online harassment, suspected cyberstalking, unwanted contact, publication or circulation of sensitive residence-related information, and related safety concerns.

PRINCIPAL REPORTED PERSON

Stephanie Kienzle, publisher of VotersOpinion.com, believed to reside in Davie, Florida.

RELATED PERSONS FOR INVESTIGATIVE REVIEW

Bruce Lamberto and Barbara Monuse Kramer.

SUMMARY

Beginning on or about March 13, 2026, VotersOpinion.com began publishing a sustained series of articles about Linda Joseph. A prior evidence review identified at least 21 dated articles through August 10, 2026; a broader audit identified approximately 26 posts referencing her. The publications and related comments repeatedly addressed her identity, residence, family, finances, religion, intelligence, character, candidacy, alleged criminal conduct, and personal safety information.

Linda disputed material accusations, requested corrections and retractions, asked that the attacks stop, and provided notice that residence-related publication creates a heightened safety risk because she is a domestic-violence survivor.

NEW ACTIVITY

After Linda served a Notice of False and Defamatory Publications, VotersOpinion.com published "Linda Joseph DEMANDS!" Parts 1-3 on August 20, 21, and 22, 2026. The August 22 article states that the notice was served by a Broward Sheriff's Office deputy on August 13. The publisher stated that Linda has never been charged with or convicted of a crime, reprinted her denunciation of antisemitism, stated that provably incorrect statements had been retracted, and offered to consider removing specifically identified personal information and objectionable comments. The site nevertheless continued publishing personal and demeaning commentary and disputing Linda's residence, birthplace, voting history, employment history, and candidacy.

RELATED INVESTIGATIVE LEADS

1. FEC 26-198, filed by Bruce Lamberto, referenced or relied on photographs of Linda's vehicle in a residency challenge.
2. Linda has original photographs she says depict Mr. Lamberto appearing to photograph or document her vehicle and can provide metadata.
3. Stephanie Kienzle filed FEC 26-139, which contained sensitive residence and telephone information.
4. An August 5, 2026 email thread shows Ms. Kienzle intentionally copying Barbara Monuse Kramer into campaign-related communication concerning Linda.
5. Ms. Kramer repeatedly engaged on Linda's personal Facebook page after being asked to stop, including comments about residence, birthplace, and credibility.
6. Linda has reported people appearing to follow or monitor her and individuals yelling hostile or derogatory statements.

These facts are submitted as investigative leads, not as proof of a criminal agreement.

REQUESTED POLICE ACTION

1. Accept this complaint as a formal police report and provide an incident/report number and assigned investigator.
2. Determine Davie jurisdiction and directly refer or transfer the report if another agency has primary jurisdiction.
3. Preserve relevant website, email, social-media, submission, publishing, and metadata records through appropriate legal process.
4. Review the August 5 email thread, Facebook evidence, FEC files, vehicle photographs, original metadata, publication chronology, and notices.
5. Determine who took, directed, received, transmitted, or submitted vehicle photographs and whether nonpublic residence, vehicle, location, or schedule information was shared.
6. Assess whether admissible evidence satisfies any applicable offense.
7. Provide victim-safety assistance and guidance regarding a stalking injunction if appropriate.

CONFIDENTIALITY REQUEST

Protect current and former addresses, apartment numbers, telephone number, vehicle identifiers, and location information to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Complete August 17 State Attorney complaint; VotersOpinion chronology, URLs, screenshots, and archived pages; August 20-22 articles; correction/retraction/safety notices; FEC 26-095, 26-198, and FEC 26-139; original vehicle photographs and metadata; August 5 email thread; Facebook screenshots/export; WakeUp NMB ethics complaint; and witness/incident log.

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
