Dear Ms. Kienzle:

This is a final response to your August 8, 2026 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, a copy of which is enclosed for your convenience. The Office of the Secretary of War/Joint Staff (OSW/JS) FOIA Requester Service Center received your request on August 10, 2026, and assigned it FOIA case number 26-F-2945. We ask that you use this number when referring to your request.

The Pentagon Force Protection Agency (PFPA), a component of OSW, conducted a search of their records systems based on the information provided in your request. After thorough searches of the electronic records and files of PFPA, no records of the kind you described could be identified. We believe that search methods were appropriate and could reasonably be expected to produce the requested records if they existed. However, if you have additional event or file-related information that indicates that we should have such information or that could assist us in conducting a further search for responsive records, please provide that information to us at your earliest convenience.
